



The Royal Commission into Institutional Response to Child Sexual Abuse

The Royal Commission has been set up to look into how institutions have managed and responded to allegations and instances of child sexual abuse. The Commission will investigate where systems have failed to protect children and make recommendations on how to improve laws, policies and practices to prevent and better respond to child sexual abuse in institutions.

People sharing their experiences will help show Australia what happened to children in the past, and help build child safe organisations in the future.
